The National World War II Memorial

Purpose: Dedicated on May 29, 2004, the memorial honors the 16 million people who served in the U.S. armed forces and the more than 400,000 who died during the war.

Design Elements:

Pillars: There are 56 granite pillars, each 17 feet tall, representing the U.S. states, territories, and the District of Columbia at the time of the war.

Arches: Two 43-foot arches at the north and south ends represent the Atlantic and Pacific theaters of the war.

Freedom Wall: Features 4,048 gold stars, with each star commemorating 100 Americans who gave their lives in the conflict.

Rainbow Pool: The memorial is built on the site of the former Rainbow Pool, which now features a central reflecting pool and fountains

### Jim Vokal, CEO of the Platte Institute and host of Nebraskanomics

Dear friend,

Last week, I was thrilled to be joined on the [Nebraskanomics podcast](#) by Nebraska Attorney General Mike Hilgers. As a former Speaker of the Legislature, successful business leader, and now Nebraska's chief law enforcement officer, Attorney General Hilgers brings a unique perspective on the challenges and opportunities facing our state.

Much of our conversation centered around a question we have been discussing a lot around the Platte office recently: how do we make Nebraska the most attractive state in the country for young talent, entrepreneurs, businesses, and growing families?

That conversation goes far beyond any individual policy debate. It's about whether Nebraska will simply compete to keep pace with neighboring states or whether we are willing to think bigger about growth, opportunity, and the future we want to build.

Attorney General Hilgers brings an important perspective to these issues. Before serving as attorney general, he led one of the fastest-growing law firms in the country and served in the Nebraska Legislature where he eventually became Speaker. Today, as attorney general, he continues to work on issues that directly shape Nebraska's future, from energy reliability and economic competitiveness to consumer protection and constitutional governance.

One of the themes that stood out most during our conversation was the connection between growth and policy.

Nebraska has enormous strengths. We are a great place to raise a family, build a career, and start a business. But as Attorney General Hilgers pointed out, success does not happen automatically.

States across the country are aggressively competing for people and investment, particularly younger workers and entrepreneurs who have more choices than ever before. That means Nebraska must think strategically about the future we are trying to build. We discussed how affordable and reliable energy is becoming one of the defining economic issues facing states across the country. Businesses increasingly make decisions based on whether a state can deliver dependable power at scale and at a competitive price. If Nebraska gets energy policy right, it creates a major competitive advantage for attracting investment and growth. We also talked about the importance of creating a thriving economy through competitive tax policy, affordable housing, quality schools, access to childcare, and strong communities. Attorney General Hilgers made an important point that often gets overlooked: people are willing to move to Nebraska when the opportunities are strong enough. The challenge is creating the conditions that make that decision easier for families, entrepreneurs, and young professionals. At the Platte Institute, those are exactly the conversations we want to continue driving. Whether it's tax competitiveness, regulatory reform, workforce challenges, or energy reliability and affordability, these issues are all connected to one larger goal: making Nebraska a state that grows. I hope you'll take time to listen to this week's [conversation with Attorney General Mike Hilgers](#). It is a great discussion about the opportunities in front of Nebraska, the challenges we still face, and why the decisions we make now will shape the future of our state for years to come. ### Justice for ALS Veterans

Veterans are at higher risk of ALS than the general public. And when they pass away, their families can be denied the full benefits they earned, because the law requires eight years of total disability to qualify. Eight years. For a disease with 2-5 years life expectancy.

The Senate held a hearing on the Justice for ALS Veterans Act. This is an important bill that would eliminate that requirement and ensure families get what they've earned. ### Grants for the Rural Veterans Coordination Pilot; Rescission

#### Notification:

The Veterans Health Administration (VHA) is sharing an update that it will rescind its regulations that govern the Rural Veterans Coordination Pilot (RVCP) grant program because the statutory authority for this program has expired. This deregulatory action is in furtherance of Executive Order 14219, which requires that Federal regulations reflect the best reading of underlying statutory authority.

You're probably familiar with DS Logon, the legacy system for accessing TRICARE-related platforms and many other government sites. With DS Logon sunset by the end of fiscal year 2026, each of the platforms that support your TRICARE benefit will switch from DS Logon to myAuth. "TRICARE offers a comprehensive dental benefit for military families," said U.S. Navy Cmdr. Xiang Li, dental program analyst at the Defense Health Agency. "Enrolling is easy, and there are many ways for families to use the coverage depending on their needs."

TDP is a voluntary, premium-based dental plan administered by [United Concordia](#). It's available for purchase by:

- Family of active duty service members
- Family of [National Guard and Reserve](#) service members
- Non-activated National Guard and Reserve members, or those who aren't covered by the [Transitional Assistance Management Program](#)

Active duty service members have separate and automatic dental coverage. They get their dental care at military dental clinics or through the [Active Duty Dental Program](#).

## **Disabled/Blind Veteran Motor Vehicle Tax & Fee Exemption**

### **What is the Disabled Veteran Motor Vehicle Tax & Fee Exemption?**

Starting January 1, 2026, all disabled and/or blind veterans in Nebraska can receive an exemption for the Motor Vehicle Tax and Motor Vehicle Fee for ONE vehicle owned and used for their personal transportation.

NOTE: if a veteran has multiple vehicles, it is recommended they look at their vehicle registration document(s) and determine to which vehicle they wish to apply the exemption.

The exemption only applies to the Motor Vehicle Tax and Motor Vehicle Fee. All other taxes and fees (e.g. plate fee, sales tax, wheel tax, etc.) still need to be paid. The outlined portion of the example registration below shows the tax that would be exempted under this new law.

A County Veterans Service Office staff member provides confidential counseling and assistance to Veterans and their families applying for Federal, State, and County Veterans programs and benefits. Federal Veterans Benefits include education, vocational rehabilitation, service-connected disability compensation, non-service-connected disability pension, healthcare, and burial benefits. Nebraska Veterans programs include a tuition waiver, admittance to a Nebraska Veteran's home, and emergency financial assistance from the Nebraska Veterans Aid Fund.

Eligibility for State financial assistance requires an Honorable or General (Under Honorable Conditions) discharge from active duty. This requirement is not met by active duty for training only. (Specific residency and service dates are required for some State Benefits)

**US to pull 5,000 troops from Germany, Pentagon says**
